The Lighting and Exhibits Technician, under general supervision, provides a wide variety of semi-skilled and skilled duties in the fabrication, construction, preparation, production, installation and care of museum exhibits. The Lighting and Exhibits Technician works with other exhibit staff, carpenters, and installers and assists other departments as needed
