Summary of Responsibilities

SUMMARY

The Body Adventure Educator is a high-energy position responsible for organizing, energizing and motivating children and families to learn about their bodies (Health IQ), set attainable physical activity, nutritional and relaxation goals (Empowerment) and sustain healthy behavior change (Wellness). This position is expected to be a positive and enthusiastic presence on campus, interacting with students and families. H-E-B Body Adventure programs are inquiry-based and designed for all audiences, including: the general public, school groups, educators, teens, adults and families. The Body Adventure Educator manages and supervises Program Presenters who deliver H-E-B Body Adventure programs at the museum. The Body Adventure Educator works closely with the Curator of Anthropology and Health to ensure that all community related health goals are met. The Body Adventure Educator participates as a member of the Museum-wide team. Reports to the Director of Education.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Integrate Health IQ, Empowerment and Wellness concepts and language into new and existing H-E-B Body Adventure health and wellness programs, workshop curriculum materials and scripts.
- Create, develop, implement, and evaluate Health and Wellness curriculum, programs and activities including training scripts, ensuring TEKS alignment
- Develop and evaluate support materials for programs and workshops including pre and post lessons and evaluation forms
- Present and/or facilitate programs and workshops as needed
- Develop interpretative materials as needed
- Participate in generating activity, program, and curriculum ideas
- Train, supervise, and evaluate Program Presenters, and volunteers
- Collaborate with Director of Play to train Gallery Theater InterActors on Health and Wellness content.
- Collaborate with Administrative Coordinator to schedule staff and volunteers in the H-E-B Body Adventure
- Coordinate, organize and maintain supplies and materials for Health and Wellness programs
- Work with Programs Coordinator to develop, implement, publicize and evaluate Health and Wellness family programs
- Maintain program statistics and evaluations
- Develop and oversee budget as assigned
- Assist with design and production of the museum Educator's Guide twice yearly
- Assist with public programs at the Museum, and outreach in the community as needed
- Serve as Food Manager for the Public Programs Team
- Manage and maintain the Children's Hospital of San Antonio Demonstration Kitchen to health department standards
- Create, develop, implement, and evaluate Health and Wellness curriculum, programs and activities including training scripts for the Children's Hospital of San Antonio Demonstration Kitchen
- Participate, as a member of the Witte team, in assigned committees and working teams
- Other duties as assigned
